

#### Building a Death Positive Community

As the epidemic of loneliness spreads, we have dedicated this past year to building a virtual community of like-minded individuals. From monthly discussion posts on our Facebook page to our growing subreddit, we have poured energy and resources into providing a safe digital space for people to engage in death positivity. Additionally, Order members had the opportunity to attend monthly Zoom events where everyone can share knowledge and connect with one another. Our robust calendar of events for Order volunteers run the gamut from death positive trivia nights to topical and meaningful trainings. Since we are geographically spread in over 50 states and many countries, it is one of our ongoing goals to foster community through our online platforms.
